## Sign Guidelines for Homeowner’s and Civic Association’s Freestanding Temporary Signs commonly referred to as Yard Signs

A school, homeowner or civic association, special district, or other public entity may use “yard signs” to advertise events and meetings to its constituents.

### LOCATION:

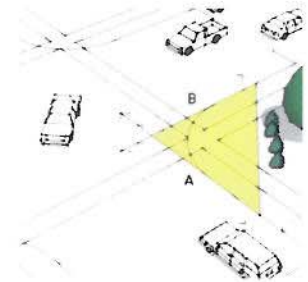
**Yard signs must be located on privately owned property set back five feet from the property line. If in a sight triangle, the sign must be less than 3 feet in height**

### REQUIREMENTS:

Sign must clearly state date of posting

The entity hosting the meeting or event is clearly identified

Statement of permission from property owner



### Sign size:

Not larger than 6 square feet

No more than 24 square feet per parcel (# of signs X size of signs ≤ 24 sf)

Not taller than 4 feet

### Sign Material & Duration:

Material	Duration
Paper or Cardboard	24 hour limit – max 90 days per year
Laminated paper; plastic lined polyethylene bags and comparable materials	Up to 90 days per year
Wood, corrugated plastic, metal, or vinyl	Up to 120 days per year

\* Along principal corridors – signs must be removed within 48 hours of the conclusion of the event to avoid being removed during City sign sweeps.

**Banners:**

Temporary site sign

May not be larger than 32 square feet

Must be posted on private property back five feet from the property line

May not be in a site triangle unless it is below 3 feet tall

Must be on stakes or attached to a solid surface

(may not be tied to trees/shrubs/utility poles)

No fee temporary sign permit is required
